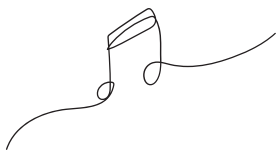

Jonathan Rea



Jonathan studied music at Cambridge, where he sang in the University Chamber Choir and studied piano with Peter Pettinger. He held choral and instrumental awards and won the Rima Alamuddin prize for piano performance.

After 10 happy years as Director of Music in Bangor Grammar School, he began a broader career in conducting, producing, writing, composing, arranging and piano accompanying. He has conducted many programmes for BBC Songs of Praise and directed the Belfast choir for Children in Need. For several years he was the Principal Examiner for A-Level Music Performance in Northern Ireland. He is the choral director for the annual Sing! conference in Nashville, for whom he has on two occasions directed choirs with 1000 participants. He now provides consultancy to a number of church-based organisations.

Jonathan is Creative Director and Chief Executive of New Irish Arts, whose choir, orchestra and youth choir perform at over 20 events per year. They have sold out Belfast's Waterfront Hall on numerous occasions, and often have over 250 participants in their larger concerts. Jonathan is increasingly in demand as a writer and speaker, occasionally contributing to programmes like Radio 4's Prayer for the Day and Morning Service.

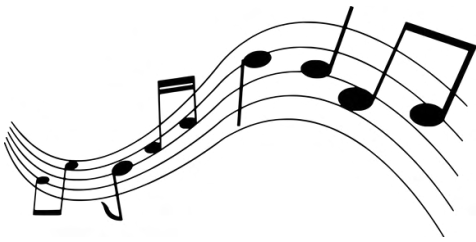


Richard Deering

Richard has been an adjudicator member of the British and International Federation of Festivals for well over 30 years, adjudicating at an average of 12 festivals a year, including many overseas festivals, as a piano or brass specialist and generalist.

His Federation work included serving on the Central Board of Trustees, Vice-Chair of the Adjudicators' Council and with the administration of the PGCA qualification. Currently he is the Chair of Trustees of Croydon Performing Arts Festival and, was honoured, by being elected as a BIFF Fellow in 2012.

Richard is also a high-ranking cricket umpire and season ticket holder at Sutton United Football Club.



Judey Struth



Judey has been involved with Festivals as a performer, teacher and parent for over 50 years. She is an Associate of Trinity College, London.

Her passion is poetry - Scots in particular - and as an adjudicator she wants to encourage teachers, parents and children to support their local Festivals and discover the fun and tremendous life-skills to be gained through performance, and is happy to adjudicate in person or online.



Jimmie Hill

Jimmie comes from Millport and learned country dancing both at primary school there and at Rothesay Academy. He qualified as an RSCDS country dance teacher 25 years ago.

While living in England he founded the Brighton Branch of the RSCDS. Back home in Edinburgh, he taught the Edinburgh University demonstration team, which regularly competed at the Newcastle Festival. He has taught at the RSCDS Summer and Winter Schools, at day and weekend schools in the UK and Europe, and has been invited regularly to teach in North America. In 2019 he taught in New York, Calgary and Seattle. He is the current editor of Scottish Country Dancer, the RSCDS members' magazine. He is a qualified RSCDS adjudicator and has judged at the Aberdeen, Dumfries, Arran, and Glasgow Festivals.





Calum Huggan



From early on in his career Calum showed a real passion for marimba, winning his first BBC Solo Broadcast at the young age of 18. A finalist in International and National competitions, Calum was taught and nurtured by international marimbists Jasmin Kolberg and Eric Sammut. Calum's passion and commitment to performing has allowed him to perform solo and concerto debuts within the major concert houses across the United Kingdom, Europe and the United Arab Emirates.

As a freelance percussionist, Calum works regularly with orchestras such as BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra, English National Opera Bayliss, Southbank Sinfonia, Scottish Ensemble, Scottish Opera, Mannheim National Theatre.

Calum is an active and sought after percussion tutor and workshop leader throughout the UK, Four Mallet Specialist at Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, Percussion and Ensemble coach at Junior Trinity (London) and a part time lecturer at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland.



Gerry Magee

Guitarist Gerry Magee graduated with honours from Strathclyde University's BA in Applied Music Course in 1998. Since then he has been involved in numerous music projects, be it virtuoso playing in a heavy metal band, arranging for a nine piece funk band or working with small jazz ensembles. Gerry's skills are continually in demand as both a performer and session musician.

For the past 17 years Gerry has also taught guitar at high schools throughout West Dunbartonshire. Many of his students have gone on to become professional musicians themselves.



Colin McGibbon



Colin is a professional drummer and educator from Glasgow. With nearly 30 years of experience, Colin covers everything from theatre pit work, touring shows including national tours with Susan Boyle, Jai McDowall and Federation of the Disco Pimp to rock/pop/jazz gigs and studio recording sessions.

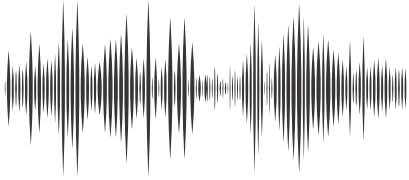

Christopher Baxter

Renowned Scottish Pianist, Christopher Baxter is in constant demand as a soloist, accompanist and chamber musician. Hailing from Aberdeen, in the North East of Scotland, Christopher began his musical studies there, with Robert Howie at the Aberdeen City Music School and continued at the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama (now Royal Conservatoire of Scotland), completing his BMus (1st Class Honours) and MMus (Distinction)

Christopher became the first Associate Accompanist of the National Youth Choir of Scotland and as a grade and diploma examiner for the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music, has travelled extensively throughout the UK and Asia.



Finlay Johnston



We are delighted that Finlay Johnston is joining IMF this year. Finlay, a world-renowned piper, having won the coveted Glenfiddich Piping Championship on two occasions, the Highland Society Gold Medal, Silver Chanter and numerous other major solo piping awards, was brought up in Tiree before moving to Glasgow.

Finlay has held the position of Head Piping Teacher at The National Piping Centre, and recently was given the honour of having one of his compositions played at the coronation of King Charles III.

With Finlay, comes the addition of two new Piobaireachd classes to the Festival.

Rana has had a long career in education, from teacher to Head Teacher, to nearly 20 years within the Education Services of Renfrewshire Council in various advisory roles, including responsibility for the areas of Art and Design, Drama and Music across the sectors.
